The Pastor Writes

With the beginning of a new year comes several exciting events in our church. Number one, the beginning of a new semester of FAITH. Our banquet is scheduled for February 21, 5:30 p.m., in the Fellowship Hall. We need your participation this semester. We have plenty of visits to be made to potential members since the end of our fall semester. Our guest speaker is Dr. Jim Butler, a longtime friend and experienced FAITH pastor through the years.

Number two, the beginning of a new year of ministry for our Deacons. Our 48 Deacons are divided into four teams of ongoing ministry to our church family. We welcome twelve new deacons to our Deacon Ministry, one of whom is Dr. Ryan Simmons, who was ordained by our church on January 15.

Number three, our January Bible Study got off to a good start on January 8. I am personally preaching/teaching it again this year on Sunday evenings during the Classic Worship Service. It will encompass several months as I talk about "How To Find Peace In A Pressure-Packed World." We are considering some very relevant subjects like "Burnout," "Stress," "Relationships" and "Living On the Edge Financially."

Over the last two months, even the most avid football fans would have gotten enough football on television to last a year (at least for me.) Yet there are always some men who remind me of the man who loved football and he spent all day Sunday, New Year's Day, watching one game after another and late into the night. Finally he went to sleep on the couch with the game still going on and slept there all night long. The next morning his wife woke up and it was late and she was afraid he was going to be late for work, so she rushed into the living room. She said, "Honey, it's late, get up, get up, it's twenty till seven." In a flash he opened his eyes, raised up off the couch and said, "Whose favor is it?"

Let me conclude this article by sharing what a blessed year it was financially for Harrisburg in 2011. Note the end of year statistics:

1. Our budget for 2011 was \$3,037,210; we received \$3,145,369. We exceeded our budget by \$108,159.
2. Building Fund Receipts were \$802,224.78. We have paid our indebtedness down to about \$1.1 million.
3. Our entire financial receipts for all causes in 2011 were \$5,334,938. (Our entire financial receipts for all causes in 2010 were \$4,777,060.)
4. Our average weekly budget need for 2011 was \$58,407.99. The average weekly budget receipts were \$60,487.87.

I am thankful for your financial faithfulness to support the Lord's work through Harrisburg Baptist Church. I remind you that we give about 20 cents out of every dollar you give through the church budget to mission causes.
